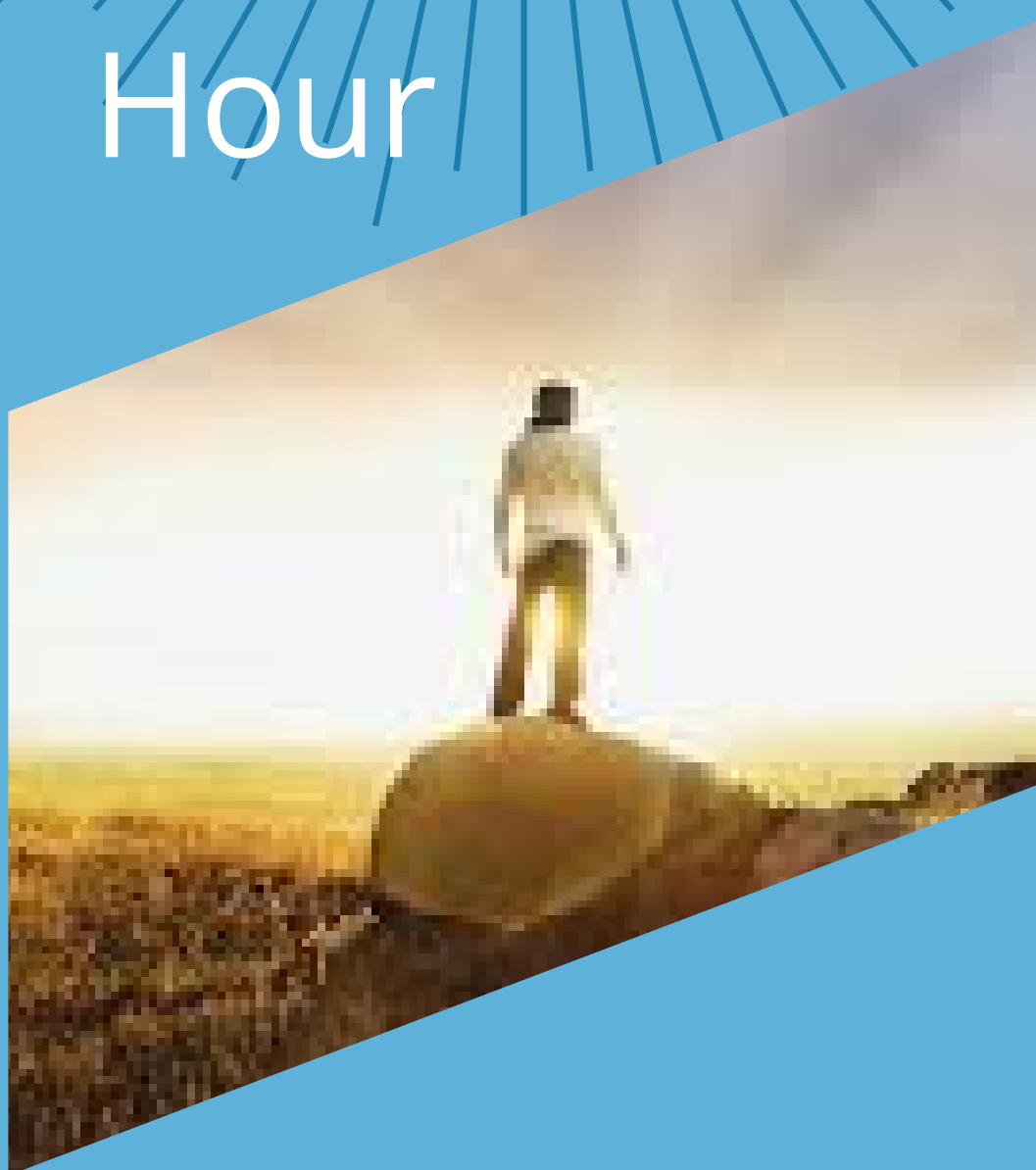




Who we are
